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INNOVATION & TECHNOLOGY — 2ND PLACE AT TINE AFRICA AI COMPETITION

The 16Plus School AI Team — 2nd Place & N200,000 Prize — TINE Africa AI Competition 2026

Competition Overview

We are extraordinarily proud to celebrate one of the most exciting achievements of this academic session. This performance brought tremendous honour to our school and has also announced our students as bold, forward-thinking innovators on a continental stage. Our brilliant tech team, comprising Mayowa Anjorin, Eniola Aiyegbusi, and Esohe Bakare, and led with vision and composure by Okechukwu Ndubuisi, represented our school at the prestigious 2026 TINE Africa AI & Technology Competition — a landmark convergence of African study-abroad practitioners, international education stakeholders, and the brightest young minds across the continent.

Participating schools were challenged to identify pressing, real-world problems and respond with technology-driven solutions that were not only innovative and practical but also ethically grounded and genuinely impactful. It was designed to separate the exceptional from the merely talented, and our students rose magnificently to the occasion. With remarkable ingenuity, intellectual depth, and collaborative brilliance, the team conceptualised and developed a cutting-edge health and wellness application that impressed judges and peers alike, earning them a well-deserved Second Place finish and a cash prize of Two Hundred Thousand Naira (**₦200,000**). Their solution was a demonstration of the kind of purposeful, human-centred thinking that defines tomorrow's leaders.

Beyond the prize and the podium, perhaps the most powerful outcome of this experience has been its impact on the students themselves. Our team returned with a trophy and a transformed perspective, describing the competition as a timely, deeply immersive platform that challenged them to think like global leaders and problem-solvers. They were inspired by the calibre of minds around them, energised by the possibilities at the intersection of education, technology, and leadership, and galvanised by a shared conviction: that Africa's future will be shaped by young people exactly like them. We could not agree more. Okechukwu, Mayowa, Eniola, and Esohe — you have made us extraordinarily proud, and we do not doubt that this is only the beginning.

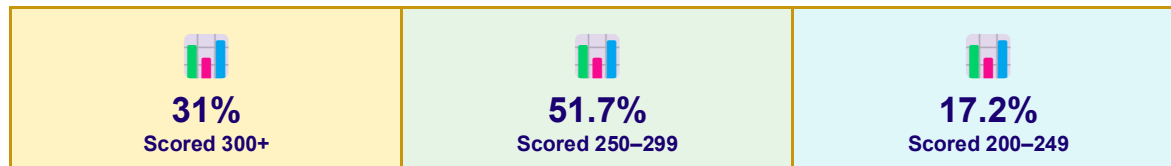

Bakare Esohe achieved the highest UTME score in our 2026 graduating class, scoring an outstanding 332 out of 400. Her achievement reflects consistent hard work, disciplined study, and the quality of teaching at The 16 Plus School.

2026 UTME Results Analysis

A total of 29 students from The 16 Plus School sat the 2026 UTME. Every single student — 100% — scored 200 and above. (31%) Scored 300 or above. The highest score was 332, achieved by Bakare Esohe Anuoluwapo.

Learning at The 16Plus School

At The 16 Plus School, quality education is delivered by highly qualified and dedicated teachers through small class sizes, personalised learning, and a tutorial-based approach that develops critical thinking and problem-solving skills. Our mentoring programme further supports students' academic, personal, and character development, creating a true "home away from home." Together, these initiatives continue to prepare our students for success in university, careers, and life.

OSSD

Our Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) programme continues to provide students with a flexible, internationally recognised pathway to leading universities in Canada, the USA, and the UK. This session, many students completed the programme and have secured admission to top universities in Canada, with a number receiving sizeable scholarships. In contrast, others remain on track to graduate in August 2026 and February 2027. We are proud to report a 100% pass rate, with 20% of our students attaining Ontario Scholar Status by averaging 80% or above.

Cambridge A-Level

Our Cambridge A Level students demonstrated significant academic growth, particularly in Mathematics and the science subjects, with many improving by at least two grades between their placement and mock examinations. The majority consistently maintained grades between A and C throughout the session. We congratulate them on their dedication and wish them every success in the recently concluded Cambridge International Examinations.

SSS3

Our graduating SSS3 students demonstrated resilience and steady academic progress throughout the session, supported by targeted interventions and the commitment of their teachers. We are confident they approached their external examinations well prepared and are optimistic about their success. We sincerely appreciate our parents' continued partnership and wish our students every success in their future endeavours.

Senior Secondary School (SSS1 & 2)

Following the promotion examinations, our SS1 and SS2 students demonstrated commendable academic growth and readiness for the demands of the next class. We encourage them to use the holiday productively to consolidate their learning and strengthen areas requiring improvement. We look forward to even greater achievements in the coming session.

Academic Achievements — UTME 2026

Our students recorded another outstanding performance in the 2026 UTME. 30 per cent of the candidates scored above 300 out of 400, with the highest score an exceptional 332, while the majority of the remaining students scored in the mid-to-high 200s; the lowest score recorded was 189. These excellent results reflect the dedication of our students, the expertise of our teachers, and the effectiveness of our academic support programmes.
