#### CAREER CONSULTATIONS: Guiding Our Students to a Brighter Future.

As the 2024/2025 academic session began, many of our new students arrived with important questions about their future. Some had already chosen their intended university courses and needed guidance on the right subject combinations at the 16Plus school. Others were still exploring their options and sought advice on both course selection and university choices.

To support them, the Careers Department began consultation right from the start of the session and continued them throughout the academic year. We held one-on-one meetings with students and their parents to better understand each student’s interests, strengths and aspirations. Personality assessments were also carried out to help clarify career directions and guide subject selection more effectively.

In addition, using the results of monthly academic assessments, we engaged students in targeted conversation to address any learning challenges and develop strategies for improvement ahead of exams. For students performing below expectation, follow-up sessions were arranged, often involving their parents, to ensure a well-rounded support system. These interventions spanned across all academic programs, including A ‘levels, OSSD, Uk Foundation, WASSCE and the senior secondary school.

This year’s career consultation has proven to be a vital part of our student support efforts-helping learners gain clarity about their career paths while also monitoring and boosting their academic performance.

#### CONTINUOUS ASSESSMENT (CAS)

Continuous testing remains one of the strongest pillars of the 16 Plus academic structure. Throughout the session, monthly Continuous Assessments across the various programs have served as both a **tool for monitoring academic progress** and a **guide for targeted intervention**.

A key part of these interventions is the **School Learning Support** program—an initiative designed to help bridge learning gaps among struggling students. This has yielded significant and measurable progress across the different academic tracks.

In addition, we are **exploring more automated and time-efficient online tools** to support learning and enhance the effectiveness of both teaching and assessment.

#### EXAMINATIONS

The academic year demanded high levels of commitment from our faculty as we prepared students in both our post-secondary and secondary programs for their external examinations. These include:

- **Cambridge A-Level**
- **Canadian OSSD**
- **UK Foundation Program**
- **WASSCE**

A **tutorial-based approach** was adopted to prepare students thoroughly for their respective exams. We are especially pleased to report that, for the first time, our WASSCE students wrote their external examination **within the school premises**—a significant milestone.

We express sincere gratitude to all parents for the **sacrifices and support** offered during this demanding season. Your **timely responses to communication, commitment to revision sessions, and continued partnership** have not gone unnoticed.

Examinations have now been concluded, and we remain hopeful for **outstanding results**

**STUDENT PERFORMANCE AND GROWTH** : Throughout the term, students demonstrated significant academic progress compared to the baseline established in their entry-level diagnostic assessments. Notably, 85% of A-Level students improved their subject scores by at least 50% relative to their initial performance. Over the course of the semesters, the number of students showing academic improvement consistently increased, while those experiencing a decline steadily decreased. These positive trends reflect not only improved learning outcomes but also the impact of strong student engagement.

Additionally, we observed a clear correlation between overall academic performance and attendance—both in regular school hours and during after-school extra lessons. We aim to build on this insight in the coming sessions by implementing more targeted and effective strategies to support continued student growth.

## STUDENT UNIVERSITY PROGRESSION – 2024 – 2025 ACADEMIC SESSION.

In the 2024–2025 academic session, all our students who applied to universities abroad received admission offers. We received multiple offers from esteemed institutions, including the University of New Brunswick, University of Windsor, University of Toronto, University of Calgary, Ontario Tech University, York University, University of Manitoba, University of Saskatchewan, University of Debrecen, University of Sunderland, Kent University, Baylor University, Michigan State University, Texas Tech University, Drexel University, and Oral Roberts University.

Our students have been accepted into a wide range of programs, including Medicine, Computer Science, Nursing, International Business, AI Engineering, Software Engineering, and Mechatronics Engineering. Those bound for Canada have successfully secured both study permits and visas.

Additionally, some of our students were awarded scholarships of up to 50% for their U.S. applications. With the recent lifting of the temporary hold on F-1 visa interviews, students with offers from U.S. universities can now proceed with their visa applications.

We celebrate their achievements and wish them continued success as they take this exciting next step in their academic journey.
