


ABOUTUS



s a British Council-accredited center, we provide the Cambridge Advanced Subsidiary and Advanced Level in two academic sessions. Additionally, we offer an accelerated A-Level programme, allowing students to complete the two-year curriculum in just one academic year, catering to those seeking a faster-paced option.

The Cambridge A-level is our core programme, recognized for its dynamic curriculum accepted by universities globally. It provides direct entry to institutions in Nigeria, the UK, Africa, and Europe. In the US and Canada, it earns credit for some courses, emphasizing an advanced curriculum that enhances critical thinking and practical application of knowledge.





ABOUT THE CAMBRIDGE ADVANCED LEVEL PROGRAMME

01

Students take three career-relevant subjects.

ONTARIO SECONDARY SCHOOL DIPLOMA (OSSD) (GRADE 10-12)

01

We offer this in partnership with Convoy International Academy, Canada.

02

Compulsory subjects: English language, Advanced Functions, Calculus and vectors, and Ontario Literacy Course.

03

Three additional subjects relevant to the student's course of study and the Ontario Literacy course.

04

Period: 9 months (September to June).

05

Students get 3 to 5 university offers with scholarships



ONTARIO SECONDARY SCHOOL DIPLOMA (OSSD) (GRADE 10-12)

06

Highly successful because the many assignments consolidate learning and allow for bit-by-bit accumulation of scores and improvement on previously submitted assessments, thereby improving the scores.

07

This programme exposes students to the Canadian curriculum, improving their chances of excelling in Canadian universities.

Students are enrolled with an Ontario Education Number (OEN), making them local high school students exposed to scholarship opportunities available to local students.

08

We have recorded 100% passes, with the highest being about 92% and the average 85%, 80% of our students are Ontario scholars with an average of 80 and above.

09

Our OSSD students have progressed to the University of Alberta, Simon Fraser University, the University of Calgary, Carleton University, Brock University, Ontario Tech University, the University of Windsor, and Trent University, among others.

DUAL CREDIT PROGRAMME-USA

This program allows secondary school graduates to obtain college credits while still in Nigeria and transfer them to many US or Canadian universities. It will enable them to take fewer courses, fast-track their stay at the university, and ultimately pay less tuition.

Students can take up to six courses in a semester or 12 courses the entire year, with some compulsory courses in English, science, and humanities.

Lecturers from Valley Forge Military College and Jacksonville University will deliver the curriculum, and these institutions will also issue certificates of completion. Citizens High School in Florida, USA, is our program partner. It is a school with more than 40 years of expertise, providing students with the opportunity to pursue their dreams.

In collaboration with City College Oxford, the International Foundation Year (UK Foundation) is similar to the A-Level programme. It can be used for direct three year university admission to the UK. Over a hundred universities in the UK accept the UK Foundation for direct entry admissions.

NCC Education awards the International Foundation Year, and our partner offers four pathways:



To complete the qualification, students must study and pass eight units – six core units and two elective units. Assessments are offered in several cycles throughout the year, using examinations or coursework assignments.
